### 1. Licensing Qualifications

Accredited Licensing Qualification – is a qualification accredited at the time of its award and awarded by a body accredited at that time. On 7 February 2005 the Secretary of State accredited the first 2 personal licence qualifications under the 2003 Act, they are:

Certified Licensing Qualification – is a qualification awarded before February 2005 which the Secretary of State has certified is to be treated as if it was an accredited licensing qualification.

Equivalent Licensing Qualification – is a qualification obtained in Scotland or Northern Ireland or in the European Economic Area which is equivalent to an accredited or certified qualification.
