- Your support provider
- Your care manager
- Your friend



The shop can call one of these people to help you.

If you do not have a Safe Place Card, its ok.  
People at the shop will still help you.

We are telling people again about the Safe Place Scheme in Bracknell Forest.

It is now for more people than before:



- People with learning disabilities
- People with autism
- People with dementia
- People with physical disabilities
- People with mental health issues
- People who are hard of hearing
- People who are partially sighted
- Older adults
- Young people who go missing, are at risk of child sexual exploitation and children with needs/disabilities

The scheme helps you if you feel worried or scared when you are out and about.



You can go into a shop or business that has this sticker in the window:



Somebody in the shop or business will help you.



If you want to join the Safe Place Scheme, you can carry a Safe Place Card like this:



You can put your name on it so that people in the shop know who you are.
