

# Frost's Folly & Warfield Church

This route has been selected as part of a series of easy access routes which Leisure Services will be issuing over the next two years.

These routes have not been specifically adapted for wheel chairs or scooters but they are free of stiles and other serious obstacles which make rural paths difficult for the less mobile. In all cases the surface is adequate but some sections will be rough and difficult for manually propelled wheelchairs. The guide notes clearly indicate the degree of severity.

Enjoy the opportunity to get out and about and please let us have feedback and comment on how well they meet your mobility needs.

## Wheelchair Ratings

The following categories should act as a **guide** to the overall difficulty of the routes for wheelchair users. Please consider these and your own abilities carefully before setting out on your route.

**Easy** - No more than normal outdoor fitness or exertion required.

**Moderate** - Short stretches may be moderately strenuous. The surface may be stony with some gradients.

**Challenging** - Stretches will be strenuous. Unsurfaced paths may be bumpy and stony with some significant gradients.

Most battery operated wheelchairs and scooters will cope easily with the Easy and Moderate Routes.

Coming north along the A3095 from Bracknell, turn right into Bowyers Lane just past the Garden Centre. Bear right into Wellers Lane and the car park is 20 metres along the road on your left.

# Frost's Folly & Warfield Church

A delightful circuit in the heart of rural Warfield with fine views of the church and countryside.

**Distance** - 2.5 km

**Surface** - concrete or tarmac with one short section of well worn gravel

**Gradient** - moderate

**Obstacles** - one accessible gate and one large accessible kissing gate

**Wheelchair Rating** - moderate

- 1 From Frost's Folly countryside car park (named after Chris Frost who generously gave the plot to the Parish Council, but was sadly killed in a motorbike accident), follow the farm track (footpath) through the gate at the lower end and continue gently downhill, through the zig-zag 2 and up the other side.
- 2 At the waymark sign turn right through the accessible kissing gate into St. Katherines Drive and into Church Lane. The origins of the Parish Church of St. Michael the Archangel date back to the 11th century and a visit is well worthwhile if you have time. (A separate leaflet on the church is also available from the Council).
- 3 Bear right along Church Lane with St. Michael's on your left. At the T-junction with Osborne Lane 5 bear right into Westhatch Lane.
- 4 Turn right into Wellers Lane at the next T-junction, and continue up the quiet, narrow lane until you reach Frost's Folly car park on your right after approximately 200 metres.
