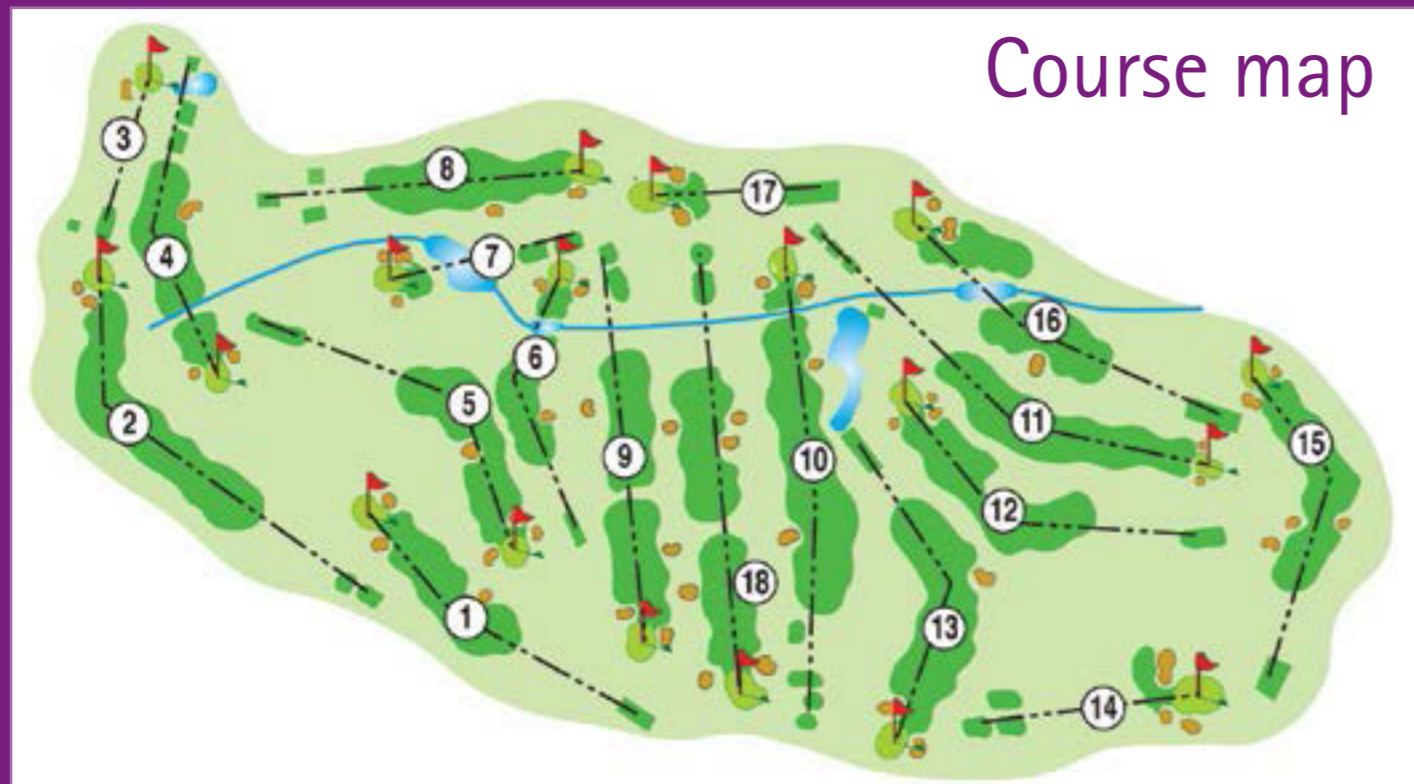

Local Rules and General Etiquette

GENERAL ETIQUETTE

Everyone should enjoy their golf and a little consideration will help both you and other players on the course. In the interest of ALL, players should play without delay (but not before those in front are out of range). Players searching for a ball should signal the players behind to play through as it is apparent that the ball will not easily be found. Players should always:

- Replace all divots.
- Smooth out bunkers after use.
- Repair all pitch marks on greens.
- Do not take trolleys or bags on to tees or greens (including the immediate surrounds).
- Clear the greens quickly on completion of putting (please do not place trolleys or bags at the front of the green as this holds up play for those following).
- Players must always obtain a green tee receipt from the Professional's shop before play. It must be retained for inspection on the course.

LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS
a) Beyond any fence, hedge or wall bounding the course. b) 16th fairway when playing the 11th hole. c) 11th fairway when playing the 12th hole. d) 9th fairway when playing the 6th hole.
2. WATER HAZARDS
Water hazards area defined by yellow stakes, lateral water hazards by red stakes. Unmarked ponds and ditches are water hazards and unmarked ditches running in the general direction of play are lateral hazards.
3. STONES IN BUNKERS
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.
4. YOUNG TREES
Staked trees are immovable obstructions. If the staked tree interferes with the swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped clear within one club-length of the nearest point of relief no penalty.
5. POP-UP SPRINKLERS, WATER SYSTEMS COVERS, FAIRWAY YARDAGE MARKERS AND CUT HOLES NOT IN USE These are immovable obstructions. Relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played, intervenes between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows:
a) If the ball lies on the putting green it may be lifted and placed not nearer the hole, at the nearest point at which intervention by the obstruction is avoided. b) If the ball lies off the putting green (but not in a hazard), and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped as in clause (a) above.
6. PATHS AND STREAM CROSSINGS
An actual crossing over a stream within the boundaries of the stream is an integral part of the course. Gravel areas adjacent to crossing and gravel pathways are immovable obstructions. As such, a free drop may be obtained at the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole.
7. WINTER RULES
When in force, a ball lying on a closely mown surface (fairway) may be lifted, cleaned and placed within six inches of the original spot but not nearer the hole. If the ball moves after being placed, it must be played as it lies.

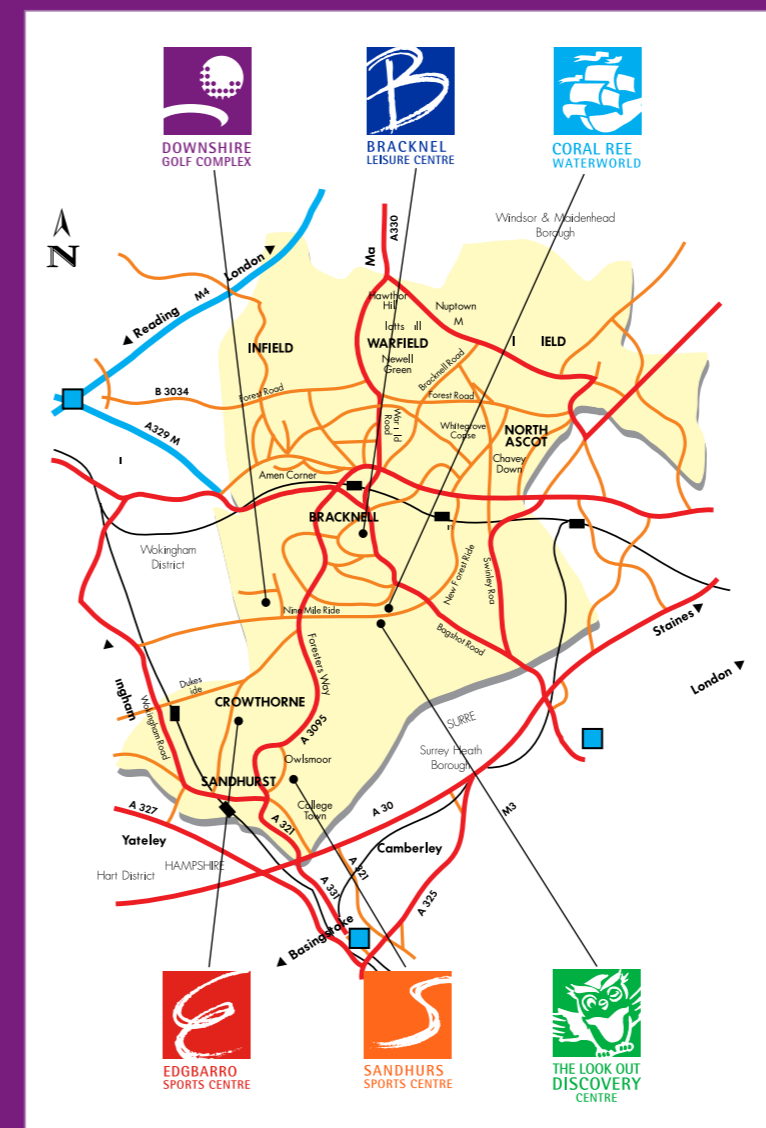
