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Notes on how to complete this form

- ❶ If the address is pre-printed, please check this is correct and make any changes where necessary. If this section is blank, please enter your current address. You can only apply for registration at your current home. You can apply at your temporary home if you currently have no other home. There are some exceptions e.g. students. If you have a query regarding your residency please contact us as shown above.
- ❶a Please date the application.
- ❶b You must enter your previous address(es). We will tell the Electoral Registration Officer for your old address(es) of your move so that your name(s) can be removed from that register.
- ❶c You must state the date(s) each applicant moved into the current address.
- ❷ Please provide contact details so that we can contact you if there is a query.
- ❸ Add the name(s) of the eligible persons resident at this address.
In order to be included in the Register, a person must :-
 - (a) be resident at an address in the area;
 - (b) be a British, Irish, European Union or a qualifying Commonwealth citizen (Qualifying Commonwealth citizens are those who have leave to enter or remaining the UK or do not require such leave);
 - (c) not be subject to any legal incapacity to vote;
 - (d) be aged 18 years or over before 1st December 2011;
 - (e) not have made a Service Declaration, Declaration of Local Connection or Overseas Declaration. These electors can register by a separate application form available by calling our Helpline on 01344 352000.
- ❸c If **born before 1 December 1993** please state your Date of Birth (anyone born on or after that date is too young and must not be included on the form).
- ❸d In the **Jury Service** box, if anyone is aged 70 years or more please put a ✓ opposite their name. An elector over 70 is exempt from Jury Service.
- ❸e If anyone would like a **Postal Vote** application form please tick the box opposite their name. For a proxy vote application form, please contact our Helpline on 01344 352000 or download a form from our website.

The full register lists everyone who is entitled to vote and may only be inspected at Easthampstead House Council Offices. Only certain people and organisations can have copies of the full register, and they can only use it for specified purposes.

The main purpose is for elections and referendums, but it can also be used for other purposes such as checking your identity when you have applied for credit and the prevention and detection of crime, including data matching exercises for fraud prevention purposes.

It is a criminal offence not to comply with the regulations. For example, it is a criminal offence either to pass the full register on to anyone or to use it for any purpose, except as allowed by regulations.

The edited register leaves out the names and addresses of people who have asked for them to be excluded from this version of the register. The edited register can be bought by anyone who asks for a copy and they may use it for any purpose.

If you do NOT want your details to appear in the edited register, please tick the box in column ❸f against your name. Leaving your name out of the edited register will not affect your voting rights or credit status.

If you do NOT tick the box, your details will be sold to anyone requesting a copy of the register and may be used for any purpose.

❸g All persons listed MUST SIGN opposite his or her name. Anyone who does not sign opposite his or her name cannot be added to the Register.

IMPORTANT

In accordance with the Representation of the People Acts, any application to be registered as a voter is subject to public inspection for 5 days to allow for objection to the application to be made. At the end of this period if no objection has been received the applicant may be added to the Register of Elector in accordance with the statutory timetable.
