LAND TO BE APPROPRIATED

Property Description

All interests in 34 square metres of land comprising service yard at the rear of Nos. 40/42 Broadway, Bracknell.

All interests in 31 square metres of land containing the electricity sub-station at the rear of the property known as No 1 Town Square, Bracknell.

All interests in 888 square metres of land and properties known as Seymour House (part), Nos 400 to 44 (even numbers) Broadway and Nos 1 to 5 (inclusive) Town Square, Bracknell.

All interests in 125 square metres of land between Nos 42/44 Broadway and Nos 41 to 47 (odd) Broadway, Bracknell.

All interests in 121 square metres of land in Crossway opposite Nos 1 to 7 (odd numbers), Crossway, Bracknell.

All interests in 52 square metres of land in Crossway between Nos 47 and 49 Broadway, Bracknell.

All interests in 124 square metres of land in Broadway opposite Nos 54 to 60 (even numbers) Broadway, Bracknell.

All interests in 81 square metres of land opposite Nos 64 to 68 (even numbers) Broadway, Bracknell.

All interests in 106 square metres of land opposite Nos. 65 to 71 (odd numbers) Broadway, Bracknell.

All interests in 63 square metres of land opposite Nos 73 and 75 Broadway, Bracknell.

All interests in 85 square metres of land opposite Nos. 100 and 102 Broadway, Bracknell.

All interests in 648 square metres of land containing the spiral access, stairways and ramps on the east of The Ring and on the west of Broadway, Bracknell and land comprising part width of the highway known as Broadway.

All interests in 350 square metres of land comprising highway known as The Ring on the west of Bracknell Town Centre, including the flying freehold over the pedestrian subway and the supporting walls and pillars connecting the Covered market on the west of The Ring with Broadway pedestrian shopping precinct.
