**THE QUEENS SILVER JUBILEE GARDEN, BRACKNELL**

The Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, in exercise of her powers under section 19(1)(a) of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, hereby certifies that she is satisfied that there will be given in exchange for the land described in Schedule 1 hereto, being an open space within the meaning of the said Act, the land described in Schedule 2 hereto, which is not less in area and is equally advantageous to the persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights, and to the public, and that the land to be given in exchange will be vested in the persons in whom the said open space is vested, and subject to the like rights, trusts and incidents as attach to the open space.

**FIRST SCHEDULE**

- 1 4841 square metres of open space including The Queens Silver Jubilee Garden, north of The Ring, Bracknell, numbered 123 and shown coloured pink on the map referred to in the above named Compulsory Purchase

**SECOND SCHEDULE**

- 1 1587 square metres of land comprising part of highway known as Station Road on the west of the Bus Station, Bracknell, numbered 142 and shown coloured green on the said map;
- 2 4041 square metres of land comprising part of the Bus Station on the east of Station Road, west of Station Way and south of The Ring, Bracknell, numbered 143 and shown coloured green on the said map;
- 3 47 square metres of part of the highway known as Station Way, Bracknell, numbered 144 and shown coloured green on the said map.
