

WESTMORLAND PARK LAWN TENNIS CLUB



RULES

(By joining the club you agree to abide by the following rules)

1. Membership

- 1.1 Membership of the Club shall be open to all residents of Bracknell Forest Borough
- 1.2 Membership will be open to residents of other areas at the discretion of the Club
- 1.3 The membership categories are:
 - 1) Family membership. [up to 2 Adults, and 4 Children aged 5 -17 inclusive]
 - 2) Adult membership
 - 3) Junior membership – i.e. Aged 5 to 17 years inclusive.
- 1.4 The Club may withdraw the membership of any member who contravenes the Rules of the Club.
- 1.5 A member's card is proof of membership and should be available for inspection when playing.
- 1.6 Members may bring only one guest on any one occasion. The same guest may not be invited on more than 5 occasions per year. Junior Members may not bring senior guests.
- 1.7 Members under 11 years of age should be supervised by a responsible adult.

2. Subscriptions

- 2.1 Subscriptions shall be subject to review.

3. Use of Courts

- 3.1 On joining the Club, members will be given a key for the lock that controls entry to the courts. Lost keys will need to be replaced at a cost of £5.00 from the Parks & Countryside service. Keys are not transferable.
- 3.2 Bookings are to be dealt with by the Tennis Club. A booking sheet will be available in the tennis courts.
- 3.3 Allocation of court time and booking arrangements shall be determined and reviewed by the Club and published on the court notice board.
- 3.4 Adult sessions are open to younger members by invitation only.
- 3.5 Bracknell Forest Borough Council Leisure Services reserve the right to have sole use of the courts at certain dates/times which will be notified to Club members in advance.

4. Coaching

- 4.1 Coaching is permitted but this will be subject to review by the Club if it causes distraction to other players.
- 4.2 All persons (including Juniors) receiving or giving coaching must be members.

5. Dress, Behaviour and Court Care

- 5.1 Appropriate attire must be worn on the courts. Tops must be worn at all times.
- 5.2 Always wear soft-soled tennis shoes. Non-marking shoes must be worn, if shoes are marking the surface you will be asked to leave the court.
- 5.3 Un-sportsmanship, noisy behaviour and foul language will not be tolerated. Any infringement of this rule will result in the player concerned being asked to leave the court.
- 5.4 The court surface may soften during hot weather, if this happens play must be stopped immediately and the courts locked.
- 5.5 Do not place heavy objects on the surface. Sharp toys, roller skates, in-line skates, bicycles and scooters etc. are not permitted to be used on the courts surface.
- 5.6 All litter must be removed from the court and placed in the litter bin.
- 5.7 After play the net must be lowered to a halfway point to release the tension.
- 5.8 When you leave the courts ensure the gate is **closed and locked.**
- 5.9 Never lean on, or attempt to jump the net.
- 5.10 Used chewing gum is to be placed in the litter-bin provided, and not left on the courts' surface.
- 5.11 No smoking within the courts enclosure, and cigarette ends are to be placed in the litter-bin provided.

6. Animals

- 6.1 **No animals are allowed on the courts.**

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COURT ADMINISTRATION

Please observe the following when booking and using the courts.

1. Court Access Times

The Courts are available for play between 8.00am and dusk.

2. Booking Forms

Court booking forms will be available from every Monday for the coming week. This service may be suspended in the event of bad weather in the winter.

3. Court Bookability

All courts are bookable except during regular Club sessions. Please note that during occasional Club events, i.e. competitions and matches, no courts are bookable. These occasions will be notified in advance on the notice board. Bracknell Forest Borough Council Leisure Services reserve the right to have sole use of the courts at certain dates/times which will be notified to Club members in advance.

4. Booking Method

To book a court, enter your name and number in the appropriate space on the booking forms. **If you turn up to play without booking, you must register your name and number in the appropriate space on the booking form, on arrival.**

5. Booking Restrictions

Courts are bookable in one-hour sessions only. Consecutive "court-hour" sessions cannot be booked against the same name/number. There shall not be more than two outstanding "court-hour" sessions against any one name/number, at any one time. A member may not book the same court and time on more than two consecutive days in one week.

6. Late Arrival for Bookings

If a member has booked a court and does not turn-up within 15 minutes of the allotted time they lose the court, and another member will be allowed to take the court, but the committee request that common sense should prevail in these instances.
