Please note that the new surface material is delivered and laid at hot temperatures and allowed to cool once rolled and compacted. The cooling process is dependent upon weather temperatures. Once cooled the surface can be driven on.

Road markings will be replaced as soon as possible after the surfacing works are complete

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will always be maintained. If you have specific access needs please approach the site supervisor who will help.

If you need help or advice about the road works on the day, please ask one of the staff on site to find you the supervisor.

Thank you for your understanding and patience while this work is being carried out. Bracknell Forest Council is committed to maintaining our roads whilst using the most cost effective methods to ensure value for money for the public. It is our intention to carry out this work as quickly as possible to reduce inconvenience for our residents.

BEWARE OF COLD CALLERS

Please be aware that our contractors will only be working on behalf of Bracknell Forest

Council on the roads and pavements. They will always be wearing their unifoms and they will never offer to do private work such as resurface people's driveways.

Upcoming work in your road

We are going to plane off and re-lay the toplayer of the road near your property

As part of Bracknell Forest Council's road maintenance programme our Contractors intend to start work on your road within the next few weeks, We will put up signs in advance to show the dates and times of the work.

To avoid costly disruption, we need to have the road clear whilst we carry out the work, so please do not park your car on the road when the works are due to take place as shown on the signs.

The process being used can be weather dependent. If it rains before or during the work, or temperatures do not suit, we may have to delay and come back later. Should this happen the road signs will be updated to show the new dates so please check these regularly.

We ask for your patience and cooperation as staff work to improve your road.

We will do our best to allow you essential use of the road, but at times we do have to close the road to all vehicles to allow materials to be laid and set, and for the safety of resident's, road users and the workforce.



What Surface treatment will be taking place in your road?

It is planned to carry out resurfacing in your road. Resurfacing involves removing some or all of the existing road surface using a road planer



We then apply a sticky bitumen spray coat to help bond the new surface layer to the road which is laid using a paver and then rolled to compact it.



Manholes and drain covers will be adjusted or replaced as required.

Please follow this important advice:

DO NOT walk on the new surface before it has cooled, as it may stick to your shoes and then damage your carpets or other flooring. Please note that Bracknell Forest Council nor its contractors will be liable for any such damage as it is your responsibility to ensure your shoes are clean.

DO NOT park your vehicles on the road during the working hours, please see the road signs for dates and times.

DO NOT drive on the new surface until it has been opened to traffic

DO OBEY the traffic control measures, such as signs or temporary traffic lights what may be in place during the works. We ask drivers to go slowly and carefully across the unfinished areas.

This process involves the use of **HOT MATERIALS**, please keep children and pets away.

We advise keeping doors and windows shut during the works to keep out dust and noise

Vehicle access to properties will not be possible whilst work is being carried out. If you know you are going to need to use your vehicle during the works, please arrange to park your car elsewhere, away from the works. If you have specific access needs please approach the site supervisor who will help.
