Resilient Network

Our Resilient Network is 118 kilometres (73 miles). In emergency and disruptive events we may be forced to, or be instructed by Central Government, to implement our Resilient Network.

A 'Resilient Network' will receive priority through maintenance and other measures in order to maintain economic activity and access to key services. We have considered which routes are essential and which can be done without for a time. It is implicit that these decisions will not simply follow road classification or categorisation.
