WNP - Designated Area Consultation (Boundary Change)

Dear Bracknell Forest Council,

Please find below our statement for submission to progress with the changes to the Designated Area. I have also attached an appropriate boundary map.

- The boundary must be changed in some way to avoid having more than one neighbourhood plan covering a single area which is contrary to the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations. This means that it is appropriate to exclude the land lost from Winkfield parish but not to include the land gained from Bracknell Town and Warfield Parish, which have made neighbourhood plans.
- None of the areas that are being lost contain significant additional numbers of residents or built development. As such, they will not materially affect the consideration of the objectives of the Neighbourhood Plan or the intention of any of its policies.
- That the boundary change will ensure that the Neighbourhood Area is almost contiguous with the parish boundary. This will help ensure that administration and monitoring of the Neighbourhood Plan can be undertaken efficiently and effectively (not having to assess and gather information from parishes outside WPC's jurisdiction).
