Information Regarding Appeals

School Admissions, September 2024

If we were unable to allocate your child a place at your preferred school(s), you have the right to appeal for a school place and attend the appeal hearing under the School Standards and Framework Act 1998. An Independent Appeal Panel will be formed to consider your appeal convened under the School Admission Appeals Code issued by the Department for Education.

Completed appeal forms must be returned by the relevant date (confirmed below) to be heard in the summer term (prior to the beginning of the new academic year). Appeals received after this date may not be heard in the summer term (within the appeal rounds) and may have to be heard after the new academic year begins (from September 2024).
