Strategic Management and Monitoring (SAMM) Tariff from 1 April 2024

The Thames Basin Heaths Joint Strategic Planning Board (JSPB) has agreed that the tariff applied to new dwellings built within the Thames Basin Heaths Special Protection Area (SPA) buffer zone, and used to fund the SAMM project, should increase annually in



line with inflation. This is necessary to ensure sufficient income is raised to cover the costs of the SAMM project in perpetuity. Without this change the SAMM project would be at risk of being unable to deliver its objectives, and therefore secure positive outcomes for the SPA.

In Bracknell Forest the SAMM tariff was last updated in April 2021. This was calculated on an average of £796.95 per dwelling. From 1 April 2024 Natural England advises that the SAMM tariff for an average 2.4 persons dwelling will be £956.69. This equates to £398.62 per person occupancy. Bracknell Forest will apply the new level of developer contributions to planning applications validated from 1 April 2024. The following tables provide updates to Table 1 in the Thames Basin Heaths SPA Supplementary Planning Document (2018).

From 1 April 2024, NE advised that the proportional 5km - 7km tariff for an average 2.4 persons dwelling will be £276.10 (£115.04 per person).
