



## Participation Opportunities for care leavers

Meet & Eat is a group of care leavers who meet up once a month. It's a chance to share your views about any challenges you experience as a care leaver, be listened to and together take forward any actions for change. By coming to Meet & Eat you are part of the Care Leavers Council.

You can also catch up with your Personal Advisor (PA), meet other care leavers and have a meal. Each Meet & Eat has an activity, visitor or theme too, if you have any ideas what you'd like us to include, let us know.

Every 3 months you also get to meet Senior Leaders, so ideas or issues can be shared, discussed and actions agreed to try and improve services.

Anyone who is 16yrs + preparing to leave care or a care leaver up to 25yrs is welcome. Come along, speak up and get involved.

### Newsletters

We send out newsletter every 3 months so you can find out what's been happening, upcoming activities, events, offers and opportunities. If you don't receive these, let us know so we can make sure you're on the mailing list.

### **Messages from current members**

As a care leaver it's important to me that everyone should be involved and feeling included, no matter who they are. Participation is not just about me, it's important for other young people who are younger. It's important for them to make sure that their experiences are better than it would have been a few years ago if we hadn't been involved. I've enjoyed interviewing for new staff at the council, we can tell them our experience and how they can make it different or better for someone else. I feel respected and valued, I feel I can speak and be honest about experiences. By sharing our experiences, I feel like we can be understood more, and staff have more knowledge to support young people, opportunities like this help to strengthen our voice and opportunities.
