(FOOTPATH SANDHURST 29)  
DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2025**


This Order is made by **Bracknell Forest Borough Council** ("the Authority") under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for Bracknell Forest Borough Council requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

**Bracknell Forest Borough Council hereby orders that:**

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for Bracknell Borough Forest Council shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "*The Bracknell Forest Borough Council (Footpath Sandhurst 29) Definitive Map Modification Order 2025*"

**PART I: MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP**

**Description of path to be added**

The effect of the Order is to add a public footpath numbered Sandhurst 29, which commences at approximately the midpoint of the adopted footpath (non-right of way) linking Peterhouse Close and Merton Close, point A (SU 8565 6262) running generally east for 36 metres along the northern boundary of 11 Peterhouse Close to the boundary of the Royal Military Academy, point B (SU 8568 6262) at a width of 1.5 metres throughout. As indicted by the bold dashed line on the Order plan.

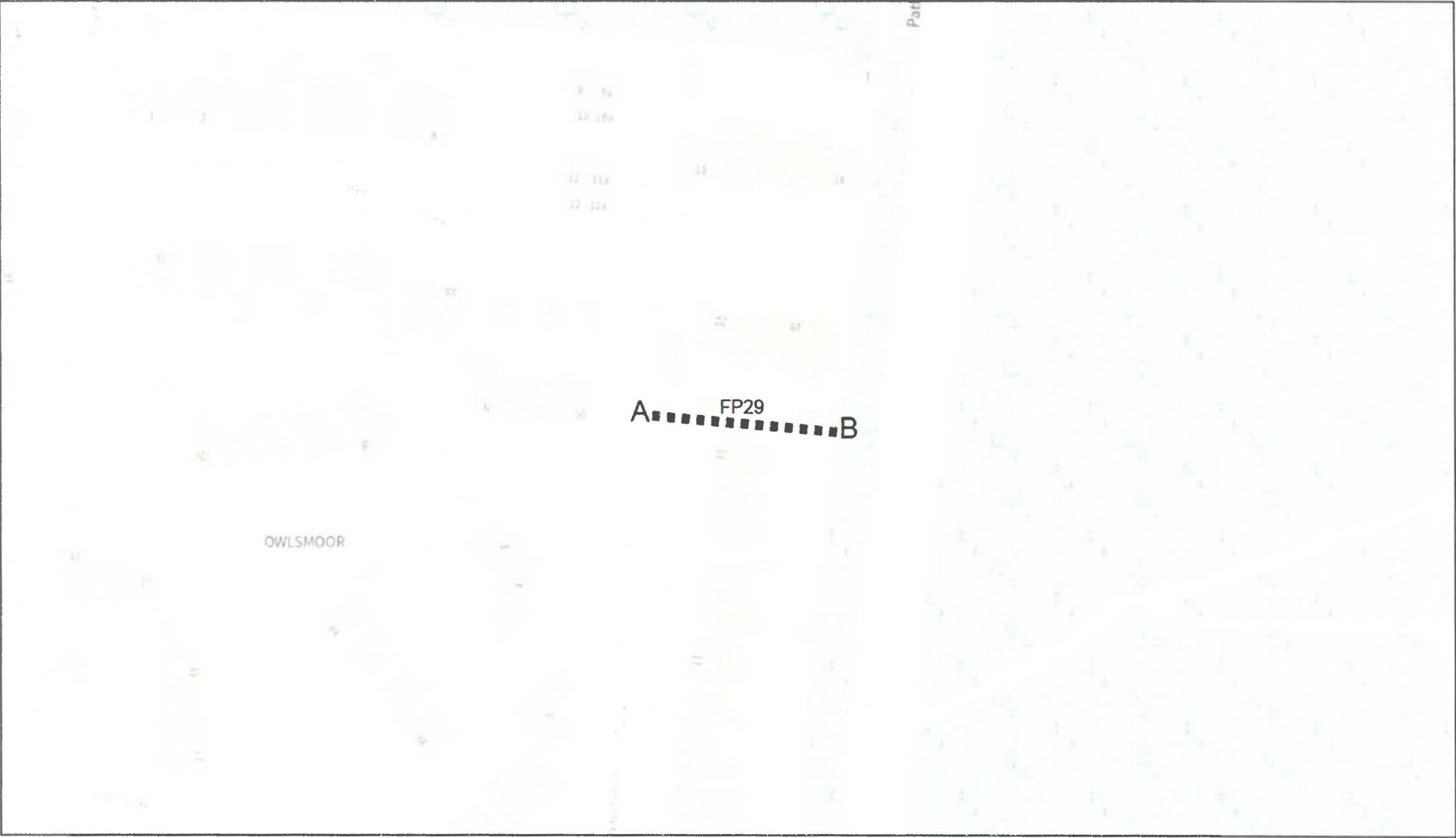
