



Statement of Community Involvement (2025)

Adoption Statement

Notice is hereby given that Bracknell Forest Council resolved to approve the adoption of the Statement of Community Involvement at the 29 April 2025 Cabinet meeting. The decision came into effect on 8 May 2025.

The Statement of Community Involvement sets out how our planning services keep you informed. It explains how people can be involved in planning matters, such as:

- the consideration of planning applications,
- the preparation of local plans,
- neighbourhood development plans, and
- other planning documents.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Statement of Community Involvement may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly in any event no later than 6 weeks after the date on which the Statement of Community Involvement was adopted.
