Allocation of places for Year Reception for the Year 2026/27

The governing body of St Margaret Clitherow Catholic Primary School has set its admission number at 30 pupils to the Reception year group in the school year which begins in September, 2026. The governing body is the admission authority and has responsibility for admissions to our school.

On 23rd February, 2026, 54 applications were received from Bracknell Forest Council to be ranked by the governors. On 2nd March, 2026, the Admissions Committee met to rank the applications according to the information provided on the application form together with the school's Supplementary Information Form (SIF), where appropriate. Applications were ranked according to the admissions criteria detailed in the St Margaret Clitherow Admissions Policy 2026/27.

Those applying on denominational grounds required evidence of baptism or evidence of membership by a religious leader, depending on the faith. Siblings applying increased the priority of an application within each category. The order of applicants within each category was then determined by the distance from home to school, as provided by Bracknell Forest Council.

The 54 applications were ranked by the Admissions Committee as follows:
