

Bracknell Footpath 5

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CLOSURE

Under Section 14(2)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the above footpath is temporarily closed in its entirety for up to 21 days from **10th June 2026 to the 1st July 2026**.

The purpose of this Order is to protect the public whilst contractors carry out essential works to clear the footpath of run-off following the recent fire incident. **Further closures may be required beyond this notice.**

The emergency temporary closure is for a maximum of 21 days or upon completion of the work, whichever is sooner. The notice temporarily prohibits the use of this footpath, Bracknell 5 by all users. The closure runs from the top of the steps off of Doncastle Road to Peacock Lane.

An alternative route for persons affected by the closure of the footpath is available utilising the urban footways of Peacock Lane, Crutchley Wood, Butler Drive and Browning Copse as shown in the plan attached to this notice.

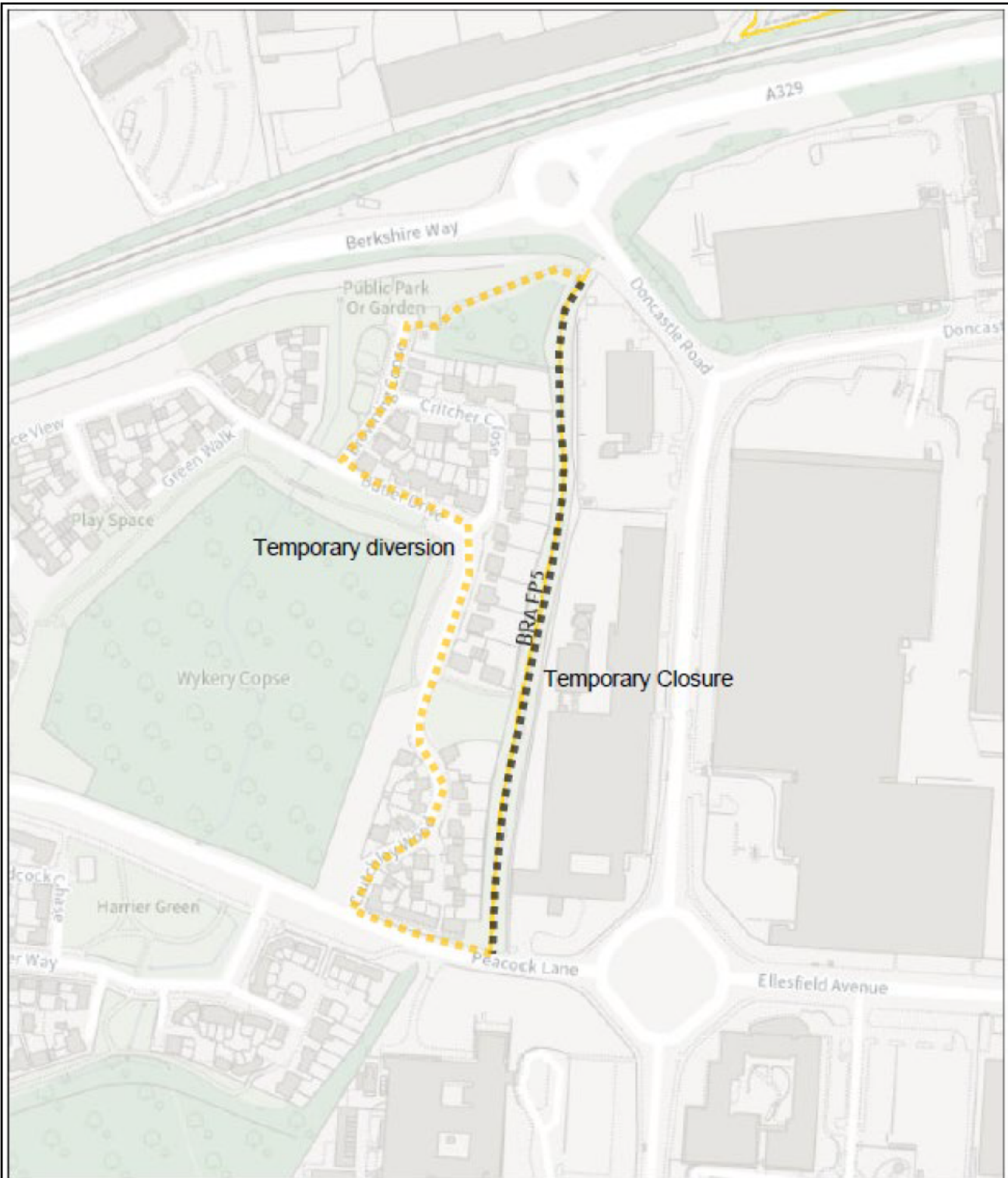
This closure shall only be in force when the appropriate signs are displayed in the above-mentioned path or way.

Temporary Closure – Bracknell Footpath 5

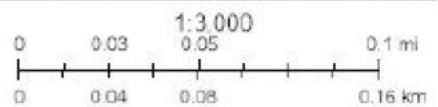
