VACANCY FOR A COUNCILLOR

Following the resignation of Katherine Giles, a vacancy has arisen which will now be filled by **co-option**.

To be qualified for co-option, you must be a British Citizen, a Commonwealth citizen, or citizen of a Member State of the European Community and be aged 18 years or over.

To qualify for co-option as a Parish Councillor, applicants must:

- Be an elector of the parish, or
- Have occupied as owner or tenant, land or other premises within the parish during the whole of the last 12 months, or
- Live within 4.8 kilometres (3 miles) of the parish boundary

All applications must be submitted to The Clerk, Binfield Parish Office, Benetfeld Road, Binfield, RG42 4EW or via email to parishclerk@binfieldparishcouncil.gov.uk

Applications will be considered at each meeting of the Parish Council until the vacancies are filled.

An application should be received by the first Friday of each month to be considered at Parish Council which meets the second Tuesday of each month.
