THE BRACKNELL FOREST BOROUGH COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY 12, SANDHURST) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2026


This Order is made by **Bracknell Forest Borough Council** (“the Authority”) under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the Act”) because it appears to the Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for Bracknell Forest Borough Council requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description. Specifically, that a public footpath be shown as a public bridleway.

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

Bracknell Forest Borough Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 15th May 2026.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for Bracknell Borough Forest Council shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the “*The Bracknell Forest Borough Council (Bridleway Sandhurst 12) Definitive Map Modification Order 2026*”

SCHEDULE

PART I: MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP

Description of path to be added

The effect of the Order is upgrade the public footpath known as Sandhurst Footpath 12 to a public bridleway to be known as Sandhurst Bridleway 12. The description of the route will remain unchanged, which commences at approximately the corner of Ambarrow Lane, west of Ambarrow Farm at point A (SU 8205 6273) and runs generally northwest for approximately 205 metres with a width of 3.5 metres to point B (SU 8187 6282) before turning generally north-north west and north west for approximately 455 metres before stopping at the borough boundary at the eastern end of public right of way Finchampstead footpath 20 at point C (SU 8163 6317) with a variable width of 2.5 metres to 5.5 metres as shown shaded grey on the Order plan. Sandhurst BR12 is indicted in its entirety by the bold broken line with cross bars in the intervals on the Order plan.

PART II: MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

The Definitive Statement is amended by the addition of the following entry:

Connections:	At western most end connects directly to Wokingham Borough Council Public Right of Way Finchampstead 20 (FINC20).
BR from:	Ambarrow Lane W of Ambarrow Farm, NW, NNW and NW.
BR to:	E end of FP20 Finchampstead at the parish boundary on the E side of Fisher's Copse.
Length (approximate):	660 metres
Width:	3.5 metres between SU 8205 6273 and SU 8187 6282. Varies between 2.5 metres and 5.5 metres between SU 8187 6282 and SU 8163 6317 as shown in the Sandhurst Bridleway 29 Modification Order 2026
Limitations:	N/A
Remarks:	Added by MOD Order, the Sandhurst Bridleway 29 Modification Order 2026, relevant date 15 th May 2026.
