Co-opted Governor Vacancy

The Governing Body of Crowthorne Church of England School has a vacancy for a Co-opted Governor.

The Governing Body's overriding responsibility is to work in partnership with the Headteacher, who we appoint, to promote continuous improvement in the performance of the school. We play an important part in raising school standards through our three key roles of setting strategic direction, ensuring accountability and monitoring and evaluating school performance.

We have five Full Governing Body Meetings a year and governors choose to sit on a committee which also holds five meetings a year. Governors are expected to attending training, provided by Bracknell Forest and visit school when possible.

The most recent Ofsted Inspection rated the school as 'Outstanding' with the following comments about governance at the school:

Governors are highly effective and make extensive use of all available information to monitor the performance of the school and to hold leaders to account. Consequently they know that the school achieves well in comparison with other schools and that the quality of teaching is outstanding. They know that teachers' progression on the salary scale is linked to their performance in the classroom and that only the best teaching is rewarded. Governors visit the school regularly to observe the work of the school. This enables them to accurately evaluate aspects such as pupils' behaviour and the effectiveness with which the school ensures that all staff and pupils are safe. They monitor the school's finances effectively to check that the school spends its budget, including the pupil premium, wisely.
