



Introduction to Domestic Abuse training

This one day multi-agency course is intended to give participants an understanding of the issues associated with domestic abuse by increasing knowledge and understanding of the issue and enabling participants to respond supportively to victims of domestic abuse.

By the end of the course, you will be able to:

- Define, name and talk about the various forms of domestic abuse
- Identify additional issues faced by marginalised groups suffering domestic abuse
- Discuss the extent and severity of domestic abuse both locally and nationally
- Describe the impact and effects of living with domestic abuse
- Identify and recognise possible indicators of domestic abuse
- Explore and discuss the difficulties when considering leaving an abusive relationship
- Examine and discuss motivations for abusers behaviour
- Understand the principles which underpin supporting a domestic abuse disclosure in an appropriate way
- Identify local policy, procedures and help available for victims of domestic abuse
- Understand how this learning may impact on your own work situation
