



Representation of the People Act 1983

**Notice of Conclusion of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places
(Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006**

In accordance with the requirements of Section 18 and Schedule A1 of the Representation of the People Act 1983, notice is hereby given that Bracknell Forest Borough Council has concluded its 2017-2018 review of polling districts and polling places for use in connection with elections.

The full council approved the following changes which will take effect when the electoral register is republished on 1 December 2018:

Binfield with Warfield Ward	The southern area of the previous 'BA' polling district has been separated into a new polling district called 'BI'.
	The Amen Corner development has been separated from the 'BA' polling district and a new polling district called 'BAC' been created.
	Newbold College is the polling place for the new 'BI' polling district.
	The Farley Wood Community Centre is the polling station for polling district 'BAC' with the electors for that polling district voting in the main hall at the Community Centre.
	Binfield Memorial Hall remains the polling station for the revised 'BA' polling district.
	Farley Wood Community centre remains the polling station for the unchanged 'BB' polling district the electors continuing to vote in the "Meeting Room" at the Community Centre.
	There are no changes to either polling districts 'BB' or 'WM' and the existing polling arrangements have been retained.
Bullbrook Ward	One additional polling station has been created at Bullbrook Community Centre to increase capacity at this polling place and reduce pressure on the two pre-existing polling stations.
College Town Ward	The main sports hall at Sandhurst Secondary School has been designated as the default polling station for electors in polling district 'SO'. Should a scheduled exam clash with a polling day, the previous arrangements at College Town Primary School would be reinstated.
Warfield Harvest	A new polling district has been created named 'WE' by splitting the existing 'WG' polling district into two areas.

Ride Ward	Westmoreland Pavilion has been designated as the polling station for the new 'WE' polling district.
	Voters in the revised 'WG' polling district continue to vote at Whitegrove Community Centre
	Whitegrove Community Centre remains the polling station for voters in the 'WQ' polling district.
Wildridings and Central Ward	The former Magistrates Court has been designated as the polling station for 'BT' electors for elections in 2019..
	Subject to a re-evaluation by the Electoral Review Steering Group and following the conclusion of planned renovation work, for all subsequent polls, Bracknell Central Library will be designated as the polling station.

All other polling districts and polling places remain unchanged following the review.

The revised polling places and polling districts will take effect from 1st December 2018.

Polling districts and polling places are kept under regular review. The next full review of polling district and polling places will take place before January 2020.
