Notice of Conclusion of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006

In accordance with the requirements of Section 18 and Schedule A1 of the Representation of the People Act 1983, notice is hereby given that Bracknell Forest Borough Council has concluded its 2019 review of polling districts and polling places for use in connection with elections.

The following changes were approved and will take effect when the electoral register is republished on 1 December 2019:
